Erasmus+ 2021-2027: budget

Erasmus+ has an estimated budget of €26.2 billion, nearly doubling the funding compared to its predecessor programme complemented by around €2.2 billion from the EU external cooperation instrument.





Erasmus+ 2021-2027: main elements



- More <u>mobility opportunities</u>: schools, adults, sport (since 2023)...
- More <u>inclusive</u> for people with fewer opportunities, more accessible for small organisations
- <u>Simplified</u> implementation for participants, with novelties like accreditations
- Flagships like European University Alliances, Centres of Vocational Excellence, Teachers' Academy, etc
- Robust <u>international</u> (= beyond EU) strand and key role in helping to prepare EU enlargement
