#### What is a EUI Peer Review?







- WHAT: An activity aimed at helping cities to design/improve their Sustainable Urban Development strategies
- HOW (method): throughout exchange and joint work with peers around Europe
- ▶ WHO, 2 possible roles: City under Review or Peer Reviewer
- Main milestone: 2-day event that brings together 3 Cities under Review, each with their group of 6 Peer Reviewers
- ▷ It's a process, goes beyond the actual event

### What is a EUI City-to-city exchange?







- Brings a city with a specific problem related to sustainable urban development ('the applicant')
- Together with 1 or 2 other cities from another EU member state with expertise to tackle this challenge ('the peer')
- Simple application form, easy to carry out, visit (between2 and 5 dagen)
- > Totally depending on the demand of the city and the challenge it brings up!
- Ongoing Call cities can apply when they want

### What are the challenges?

City-to-City Exchanges are **"bottom-up" exchange activities**. Cities can submit any challenge they want, as long as it is related to Sustainable Urban Development. These can be:

**Thematic**: Green infrastructure, housing, waste management, integration of minorities, sustainable tourism, job creation, etc.

Operational: Implementation of sustainable urban development strategies, evaluation and monitoring, data management, stakeholder engagement, cross-sectoral cooperation, and multilevel governance, etc.








We provide opportunities for cities, as enablers of innovation, to take the risk and turn ambitious and creative ideas into pilot projects that can be tested in real urban settings.

Last Call: Early 2026



#### **Innovative Actions**





Financial support: up to EUR ±2,5 million ERDF (under discusion) - maximum co-financing rate of 80%





Implementation period: 3.5 years (under discussion)
(+ 6 months of Initiation Phase and 3 months for administrative closure of activities)

Thematics: each time defined by the European Commission and based on themes identified in the Urban Agenda for the EU; to be decided

Partners: Local network in which the innovation will be developed.

Transfer cities in other EU member states to which the innovation can be transferred.

Last Call: Early 2026



#### Who can apply?

Research organisations, companies and commercial organisations, urban government authorities, consumers and civil society representatives and actors from the culture and creative sectors.

A project must have at least three partners from three different countries participating in the call and include a municipality or local authority.



### What can you apply for?

3-year research and innovation projects that focus on urban areas, in the context of achieving climate neutral and resilient cities. The call welcomes a wide range of scientific disciplines such as strategic urban research, applied urban research and urban innovation.



## How much can you apply for?

There are no fixed minimum or maximum limits for a project size. Most projects are expected to have a total budget request of around €1-2 million.

Total available budget:
Approximately €44 million
